For this reason we have worked hard to provide a variety of payment options to help you receive the dental care you need and deserve. Our goal is to help you enjoy a healthy, beautiful Smile with respect to your budget. Dental treatment is an excellent investment in an individual's medical and psychological well being. Financial Policy:

All of our fees or co pays less than \$200 will be due and payable at the time treatment is rendered.

For our patients with dental insurance: We will assist you, as a courtesy, in filing the necessary forms to help you receive the full benefits of your coverage; however, we can make no guarantee of any estimated coverage or payment. Because the insurance policy is an agreement between you and your insurance company, we ask that all patients be responsible directly for all charges. Please know that we will do everything possible to see that you receive the full benefits of your policy.

Payment Options:

Cash or Check

We are happy to offer a 5% accounting courtesy for all treatment over \$100 that is paid in full prior to treatment commencing.

Credit Cards

We gladly accept full or partial payment by MasterCard or Visa.

Pre arranged monthly payments may also be arranged and billed to your credit card on a predetermined date each month. Ask our business manager for the proper forms.

For our insured patients, rather than estimating the uninsured amount due, we will bill the exact difference to your credit card the day the insurance check is received in our office.

Special Arrangements

In special circumstances we may be able to offer a short-term payment plan. Patients would need to meet the criteria established by our accountant.
